CIT's are expected to abide by the following:

1. Maintain a neat and well-groomed appearance at all times. Men are not permitted to wear earrings. Women may wear earrings, provided they are not large and dangling (for safety purposes). No CIT may wear studs or rings in any other part of the body. If a CIT has a tattoo, it must be covered at all times.
2. Only one-piece bathing suits are acceptable for females.
3. There is a no alcohol policy (against the law in Tennessee for anyone under age 21), a no tobacco policy, and a no drug policy. This will be strictly enforced.
4. Should conduct yourself at all times, both in and away from camp, so that you will be a credit to yourself and YMCA Camp Ocoee.
5. Role model positive Christian values and principles during your entire stay at Camp Ocoee
